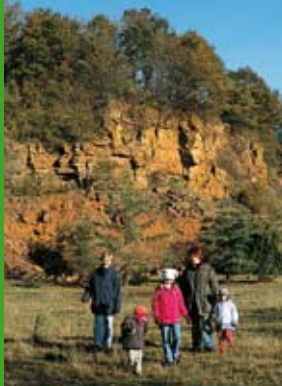

Luxembourg in the heart of the Greater Region

Over an area of 65,401 square kilometres, the Greater Region of “the Saarland - Lorraine - Luxembourg - Rhineland-Palatinate - Wallonia - the French and Belgian-speaking communities of Belgium” is located between the Rivers Rhine, Moselle, Saar and Meuse. The Greater Region has a population of 11.3 million inhabitants.

Split between Germanic and Latin cultures, the Greater Region is also strategically located at the crossroads of European development. It also has the advantage of possessing an urban, rural (Ardennes-Eifel) and industrial network which is an important source of constant socio-economic and cultural relations, great wealth and considerable diversity.

Surprising Facts

Luxembourg is the sixth smallest country and the only Grand Duchy in the world. The country measures just 82 kilometres (maximum North-South) by 57 kilometres (maximum East-West), and has a population of 493,500 comprising the highest proportion of inhabitants with a foreign passport among EU countries.

Luxembourg has more Michelin-starred Restaurants per square mile (or per head of population) than any other country in the world.

Luxembourg's Head of State, Grand Duke Henri is the youngest European Monarch.

Grand Duke Jean, the father of Luxembourg's current Head of State, Grand Duke Henri, actively participated in the D-Day landings. Grand Duke Jean is a Knight of the Garter and Colonel of the Irish Guards, and therefore rode, and now stands, immediately behind HM The Queen Elisabeth II during the "Trooping the Colour" ceremony.

Government Ministers list their direct lines in the local telephone directory.

Luxembourg has 6 golf courses, most of them within 30 minutes drive of the Capital.

The ASTRA satellites are owned by and controlled from Luxembourg. They bring you the "SKY" programmes along with all the new digital channels which are beginning to be seen on our television screens.

On June 14th 1985, on the 'MS Princesse Marie-Astrid' cruising boat, anchored at the Schengen quay, the protocol of the Schengen agreement was signed, relating to the suppression of customs controls, which entered into effect on March 26th 1995.

The famous agreement of Schengen has given this small and quiet village a wellknown name.

Form of government: Constitutional Monarchy under a system of Parliamentary Democracy.

Head of State: HRH Grand Duke Henri.
